



Part-time Firefighter/EMS Provider



The De Beque Fire Protection District is currently accepting applications for part-time paid firefighter. Application period will remain open until the opening has been filled.

The De Beque Fire Protection District is seeking motivated, highly trained EMT or Paramedic Firefighters. De Beque Fire normally runs 300 calls annual. High percentage of calls are Wildland Fire, Medical and Motor Vehicle Accidents. This position is primarily weekend staffing, vacation staffing for full-time personnel and backfill for wildland deployments.

Work Requirements:

Able to work a minimum of 48 hours per month. No guarantee of monthly hours. 24 hour and 48 hour shifts maybe available. This position is a front line firefighter EMS position. Firefighter/EMS personnel are expected to participate in training, station cleaning duties, outside yard maintenance, apparatus cleaning and maintenance.

Part-time firefighters receive no benefits other than workers compensation insurance.

Final Applicants must submit for background investigation and drug and alcohol testing.

Current certified State of Colorado EMT. Current Basic Cardiac Life Support (BCLS)

Current certified State of Colorado Structural Firefighter I or higher and current Hazmat Operations Certification or higher

Current NWCG Incident Qualification card to Firefighter II or higher (S130/190)

NIMS – IS-100, IS-200, IS-700,

Mesa County Protocol

Be able to comply with a required physicals, drug testing and vaccinations required by DFPD.

Associates Degree or higher preferred.

Valid Colorado Driver's License.

Provide the following with Application:

-copy of current EMT or Paramedic state certification, Copy of BCLS card, Copy of ACLS (if applicable)

- Copy of current Structural Firefighter I or higher, Hazmat Operations, NIMS, NWCG Certifications, current IQS Card.

-Verification that provider is in good standing on Mesa County Protocols.

-Provide resume with three references.
